## The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> September

The Feast day recalls three historical events: the finding of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine; the dedication of churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulchre and Mount Calvary; and the restoration of the True Cross of Jerusalem by the Emperor Heraclius II. If we look at this in a deeper sense, the feast also celebrates the Holy Cross as the instrument of our salvation.

An instrument of torture, designed to degrade the worst of criminals, became the life-giving tree, reversing Adam's Original Sin when he ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil in the Garden of Eden.
